

Our **no code Form Builder** allows registered users to build voting and feedback apps.


These include checklists, feedback, quizzes and appointment finding apps.

4. You get the data in your personal account





1. Your FormApp consists of Rows which are associated with a Row-Type:

2. The form can be modified as follows:
  - Drag and drop a Row-Type from the Toolbox to the desired position in the form.
  - To delete a row, drag the existing row from the form to the right into the Action area and then click on the Delete icon.
  - swap rows by drag and drop if desired

3. Clicking on the Rocket icon within the action area will take you to a preview page. There you can save the current form in the backend with "Save to Backend".

The previous page will be displayed automatically.
